What fire codes does the Fire Protection District enforce?

The District has adopted the 2003 International Fire Code

Are their fees for plan reviews?

Yes, please refer to Ordinance 2005-1 located under Fire Prevention folder

Are sprinklers required in all buildings?

Sprinklers are required in all new buildings and any existing building that undergoes a change in use. For example, if a building formerly was used as an office, and now someone is planning on using it as a store, that's a change of use that would require sprinklers.
