How to do a drill at home:

- 1. Watch the weather on the news or listen to a weather radio
- 2. Put together a family emergency preparedness kit and a special one just for kids. If you already have one, review it and check to see if any food items have expired.
- 3. Practice as if there was a tornado in the area and have them do the following: A. Grab their emergency preparedness pack.

B. Go to designated area, for example, a special place in the basement, If no basement, an interior room without windows (a closet).C. Take cover. Kneel down, tuck head down and cover the back of their heads with their hands or a pillow.
