## Fire Drill

How to do a drill at home:

1. Have your child start in their room pretending to be asleep
2. Press the test button on your smoke alarm. When your child hears it, they need to do the following:
  - A. Crawl to the door, feel the door with the back of their hand to check the temperature.
  - B. Continue to the closest exit and go to the designated meeting spot (weather permitting, of course)
  - C. If a rear door is easier to access, please make sure they know how to go to the front of the house to the meeting place.
