Minutes of the Minooka FPD Board of Trustee Meeting held on August 8, 2023

The meeting was called to order by President Roberts at 8:30 a.m.

A motion by Trustee Clark to approve the July 20, 2023 open board meeting minutes, seconded by Trustee Baron. All were in favor and the motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Clark to approve the July 20, 2023 closed board meeting minutes, seconded by Trustee Underhill. All were in favor and the motion carried.

A motion by Trustee Roberts to authorize the building committee to act on securing a construction manager & civil engineer, pending the Attorney's approval, seconded by Trustee Robinson.
