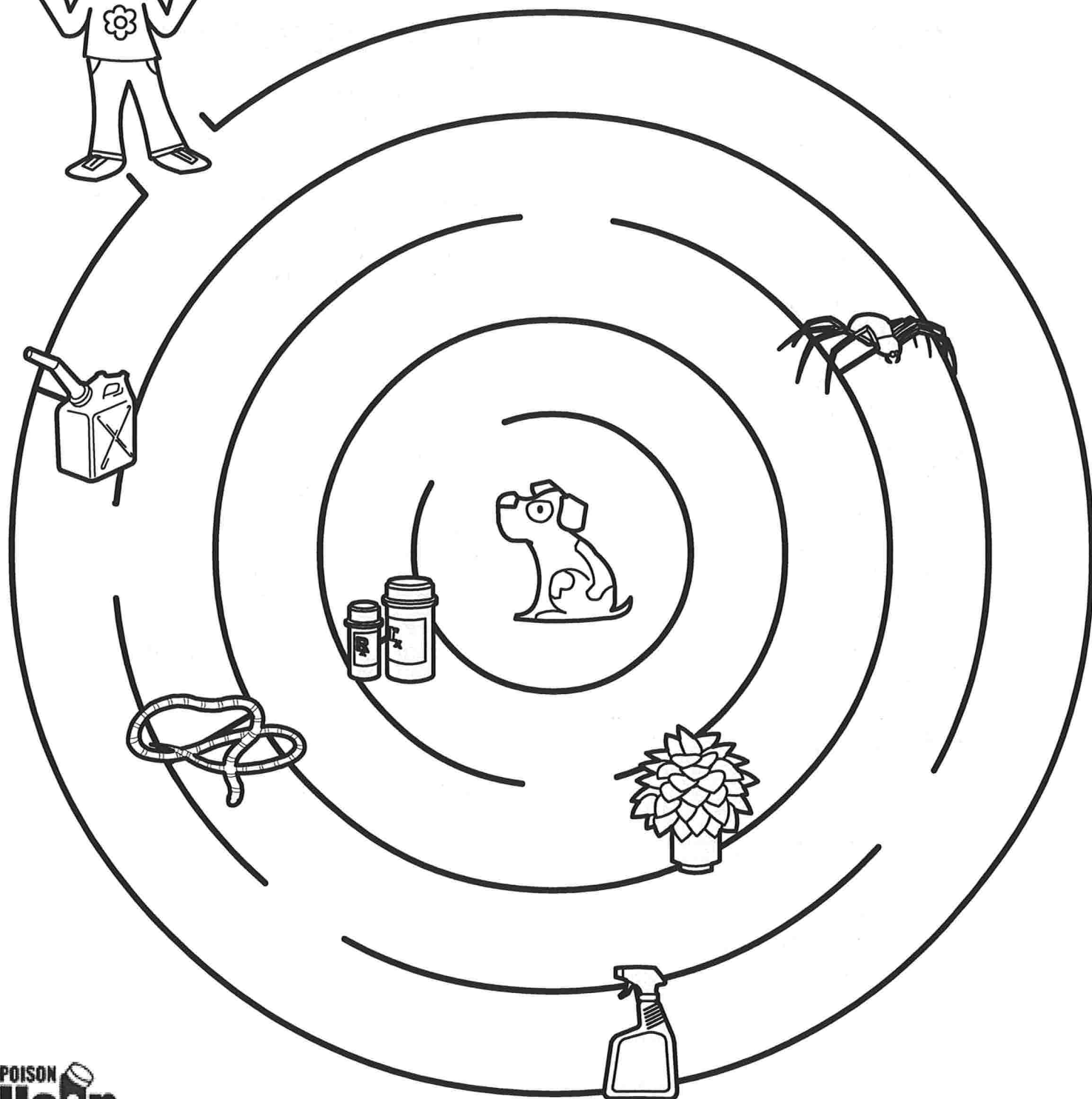
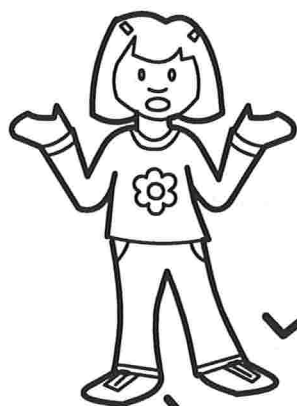


Find the Safe Path
