

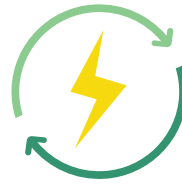


# EMERGENCY PLAN CHECKLIST



## Escape Route

Have two escape routes mapped out from my home.



## Charging Method

Identify backup charging methods for electronics in case of a power outage.



## Emergency Kit

Have a ready-to-go bag packed with nonperishable food, water, flashlight, batteries and medications.



## Family Practice

Practice emergency plans with every family member.



## Include Pets

Help my pets by getting them used to a leash or carrier during stressful situations.



## Get Alerts

Download an emergency notification app on your phone.



## Meeting location

Set a meeting location outside of my home to reunite after an evacuation.



## Check Generator

Ensure my backup generator is ready to safely operate in case of a power outage.



## Central Contact

Designate an out-of-state contact to relay information to my family and friends.



## Fire Extinguishers

Know the location of fire extinguishers. Check the gauge to make sure they are charged.



## Garage Door

Know how to manually open my garage door in case of a power outage.



## Smoke Alarms

Check smoke alarms once a month, replace batteries twice a year. Replace if smoke alarm is over 10 years old.
